

## Camp Joy Rules and Regulations

### GENERAL RULES

1. No use of Tobacco products
2. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs
3. No firearms or fireworks
4. No fires except in designated areas at designated times
5. No defacing or destruction of property
6. No chasing or harming of wildlife
7. No cutting or removal of trees or plants
8. Park all vehicles in designated areas
9. Campers must remain on camp property at all times (the swinging bridge is not on camp property)
10. All recreational equipment is to be returned to storage each evening
11. No bare feet allowed except when in bunk or shower
12. If parent signed health and registration forms are not brought to Camp Joy before or at the time of registration, the camper will not be allowed to register and will be sent home. The purpose of this rule is for the legal protection of both the camper and Camp Joy.

### Dorm Rules

1. No defacing of dorms and/or furnishings
2. No removal of mattresses from beds
3. No removal of mattress covers from mattresses
4. No walking or jumping on beds
5. Do NOT operate hotplates, refrigerators or other appliances
6. Boys are not permitted in girls' dorms nor girls in boys dorms under any circumstances

### Dining Hall Rules

1. Be properly dressed for meals – no PJs, swimsuits, etc.
2. Shirts and shoes must be worn
3. Do NOT remove food from dining hall
4. Garbage will be separated into paper and non-paper items and placed in plastic bags for disposal.

### Pool Rules

1. The Lifeguard is in charge at the pool and must be obeyed.
2. The pool area is off limits except during specified swim times

### River Rules

1. Canoes or tubes may be used only with permission of the director and with adult supervision at all times
2. Life preservers must be worn at all times
3. Shoes must be worn at all times during river activities
4. Fishing is permitted with the consent of the director under conditions specified by the director.
5. Canoes, tubes or any other amphibious crafts must be returned each evening.
